Application Packet for Spring and Fall 2012 Scholarships



Terry L. Priest spent his entire professional career seeking ways to provide opportunities to students who are interested in pursuing transportation, logistics, or supply chain careers. He was born in Shoshone, Idaho in 1942. Terry began his employment as an Agent/Telegrapher with the Union Pacific Railroad, with time out for military duty. He then went to work for J.R. Simplot Company as a Corporate Traffic Manager with the provision that they would pay for Terry's higher education. Terry went on to achieve a bachelor's degree in business aviation and transportation from Boise State, then a master's degree in transportation law. During the years, he also studied at Syracuse University and MIT. Terry then went to work for Coors Brewing Company in Golden, Colorado as a Corporate Commerce Manager. After an 18-year career with Coors Brewing Company, he turned to teaching at the University of Colorado at Denver. He held the highest leadership posts at the American Society of Transportation and Logistics, whose mission is to advance transportation education. In addition to the many awards Terry earned over the years, he was awarded the Lifetime Achievement Award by the Colorado Transportation Community for his dedication to transportation education. Mr. Priest passed away on May 19, 2002 at the age of 60. The Terry L. Priest Scholarship Fund was created through donations made by numerous friends and professional associates to an endowed fund established in Terry's memory.

The Selection Committee is seeking applicants who are committed to the field and passionate about the industry. Up to three students will be selected to receive a scholarship award this year through a competitive process. Award amounts will range from \$1,500 - \$5,000. Scholarship money can be used toward tuition and fees for the spring and fall 2012 semesters/terms.

Eligibility

Applicants must:

- Be enrolled in an undergraduate transportation, logistics, or supply chain program at an accredited four-year college or university in the United States (full-time or part-time);
- Have a cumulative G.P.A. of 3.0 or higher;
- Plan to pursue a career in the transportation, logistics or supply chain field; and
- Have financial need.

Please note that applicants who are related to a member of the scholarship selection committee, Denver Transportation Club or a Denver Foundation employee or board member are not eligible to apply.

Application & Selection Process

Print and mail the application along with the *three additional items* requested on page four in one packet to: The Terry L. Priest Scholarship Fund, c/o The Denver Foundation, 55 Madison Street, 8th Floor, Denver, CO 80206.

Application packets must be postmarked on or before **November 4, 2011**. Please note that this deadline is taken seriously. Incomplete applications and applications that are postmarked after the deadline will not be considered. *Please do not use staples or binders other than paper clips.*

A letter or email will be sent to each applicant regarding the selection committee's decisions on or before December 9, 2011. Applicants will be selected based on academic achievement, commitment to the field, and financial need. Previous applicants and recipients are welcome to apply.

The 20112 scholarship recipients will be honored at Operation Stimulus which will be held in Denver, CO from January 26-28, 2012. Information about the annual event can be found at www.denvertransportation.org. Scholarship recipients are encouraged to attend this event.

Additional reference letters from professors, faculty advisors, and/or paid or volunteer work supervisors may also be submitted but are not required. Recommendation letters *must* be on letterhead.

B. Transcript(s) of Grades

Submit a transcript for **all** college level work that you have completed. If you have completed work at more than one school, be sure to provide a transcript from each school. Unofficial transcripts are acceptable. Applicants who are selected to receive a scholarship may be required to submit official transcripts for verification.

c. Resume

Include a resume that details your education, work experience, internships, degrees and/or certificates earned, certifications, honors, awards, etc.

Signature *A written signature is required for an application to be complete.*
